This class will cover situations when a utility would need a generator, along with regulations, standards and laws regarding those situations. Generator uses, standby power considerations, transfer switch considerations and operation and maintenance considerations will also be discussed. Participants will learn to plan for the size, fuel source, installation, and maintenance of a generator for their utility to use during an emergency situation. Requirements for developing an Emergency Response Plan and updating it will also be covered. An IDEM template will be used to provide a guide for utilities to use as a tool and mechanism to manage emergencies effectively.
